

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) in Nursing

Type of activities

1. Training, seminar, workshop.
2. Research, publication in journal, publication research or books.
3. Community services based on community empowerment, such as social activities, providing health campaign, disaster rescue and services actively participate in professional development and professional association activities.

CPD Principal

1. Self directed and practice based
2. Requirement:
 - a. registration status extension
 - b. upgrading the career ladder
3. Goals :
 - a. nursing services improvement
 - b. professionalism improvement inline with the professional standard

Credit requirement for extension registration status

Minimum 25 credits in 5 years consist of:

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| a. providing practice in nursing | 10 - 20 % |
| b. participate job related training | 40 - 80 % |
| c. conduct research, publication | 0 - 20 % |
| d. participate in community services or professional development | 0 - 20 % |
