

Registration & Licensing

Two levels of licenses are available for the licensing examination. First class license will be issued to a professional nurse who graduates from a 4- year program and the second class license will be issued to technical nurse who graduate from a 2- year program.

All graduate nurse-midwives or nurses from accredited nursing schools who pass the national licensing examination will be registered and given a license to practice from the Nursing and Midwifery Council. The Nursing and Midwifery Council requires renewal of the license every 5 years, requirement for renewal is 50 unit-hours of continuing education. All Licenses will be signed by the General Secretary and President of the Council.
